


What happens when I get to school?

Jakub is popping his book bag in the box in his classroom.


Everyone who brings a lunch box has already put them on the trolley ready for when they will need them later.

Jakub, William and Ellie have all hung up their coats nicely on their coat pegs.




Are you excited about coming to school?

What happens at the end of the school day?


When school is finished for the day we sit together on the carpet to listen to a story. We will also talk about the fun things you have been doing and learning during the day.
