It is our policy that children wear school uniform. In addition to giving children a feeling of belonging to their school, it is also more practical for parents. We also believe it is important that certain activities are facilitated by specialised and appropriate clothing when attending school, or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours. Aims

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents
- Has been designed with health and safety in mind

Our colours are blue, grey and white and the uniform is as follows:

Boys

- Blue sweatshirt with or without school logo
- Blue jumper
- Grey trousers or grey shorts
- Black shoes

Girls

- Blue sweatshirt with or without school logo
- Blue cardigan/jumper with or without school logo
- Navy skirt or grey trousers
- Gingham summer dress
- Black shoes

For PE all children need

- Blue t-shirt with or without school logo
- Black or blue PE shorts
- A pair of trainers for outdoor PE
- Plimsolls for indoor PE
- Tracksuit for outdoor PE

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school, with the exception of stud earrings. These should not be worn to school on days when children have PE.



Make up and Cosmetics

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children, unless there is a specific event for which the Head has given permission.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
